Richard Dixon, 76, of Evansville passed away Thursday, November 27, 2008 at St. Mary's Medical Center.

Mr. Dixon worked at Potter & Brumfield in Princeton, IN for 35 years before retiring in 1988 as the Executive Vice President. After his retirement he taught classes at Ivy Tech Community College. He was a Sergeant in the United States Army, serving as a paratrooper in the 11th Airborne Division out of Ft. Campbell, KY. Mr. Dixon had served on the Board of Directors at the University of Southern Indiana, was a 1968 graduate of the University of Evansville, a member of the National Rifle Association and the Red Brush Gun Club. He currently holds several local and national records for target shooting.

Surviving are his wife of 56 years, Betty (Myers) Dixon, a daughter, Jackie Craig and her husband, Bill of Evansville; two sons, Rick Dixon and his wife, Beth of Evansville and Scott Dixon of Evansville.
