Richard D. Torres, Sr., age 73, of Evansville, passed away April 24, 2019 at the Linda E. White Hospice House surrounded by his family.

Richard was born December 4, 1945 in Ramona, CA to the late Louis and Concepcion (Enriquez) Torres. Richard was the president, owner and operator of Torres Insurance Agency, a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County and an Independent Insurance Agent. He was also a veteran of the United States Army and member of American Legion Funkhouser Post 8.

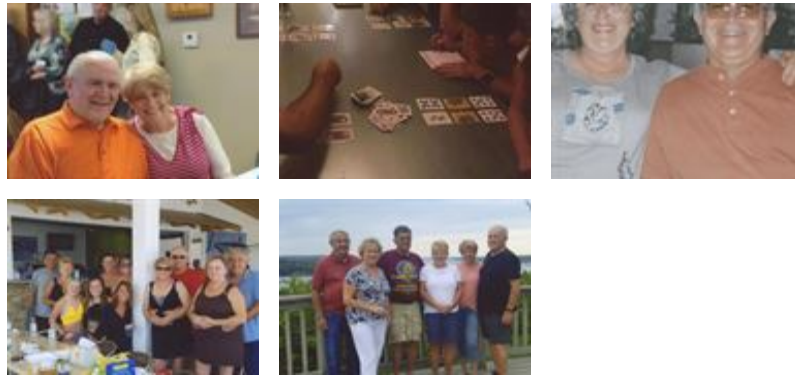
