Rick McCormick, 65, of Evansville, passed away on Friday, June 27, 2025, at Ascension St. Vincent Heart Hospital in Carmel, Indiana, surrounded by his loving family.

Rick was born on January 31, 1960, in Evansville to Barbara Jean (Carlisle) McCormick and the late Billie Mack McCormick.
