Robert A. "Bob" Brinkmeyer, 85, of Evansville, passed away at his home on Thursday, January 18, 2024.

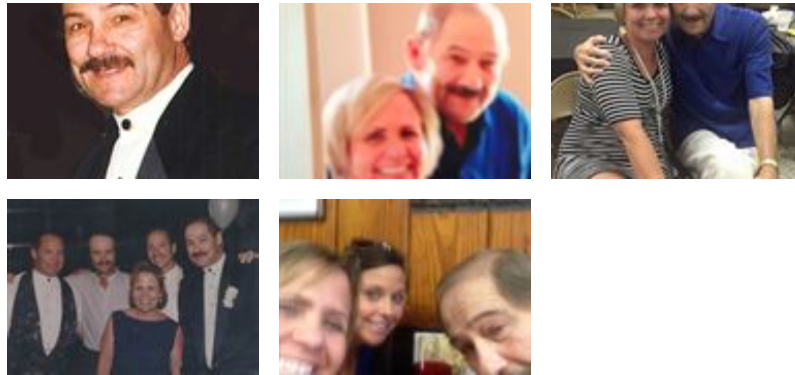
