



## Robert Deeg

April 23, 1936 - October 31, 2006

Robert A. (Bob) Deeg, 70, of rural Evansville, died Tuesday, October 31, 2006 at St. Mary's Medical Center.

At the time of his death he was employed as a staff pharmacist at the Evansville State Hospital. He and his wife, Julie, formerly owned West Side Pharmacy and Deeg's Hallmark in Evansville and Sandy's Hallmark in Mt. Vernon.

Bob was a graduate of Butler University College of Pharmacy and was a member of the Indiana Pharmacists Alliance and the Southwestern Indiana Pharmaceutical Association.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Emil and Mae Kathryn (Kitty) Deeg.
