Robert E. Feldhaus, 84, of Evansville, passed away Monday, June 26, 2017 at the West River Health Campus.

Bob was born September 19, 1932 in Evansville to the late Carl and Irene (Humpert) Feldhaus. He worked at Alcoa for 28 years before retiring in 1992. Bob was a longtime member of St. Boniface Catholic Church, a veteran of the United States Army serving in the Korean War, an avid golfer and member of Twin Towers, VFW Post #1114 and the Alcoa 25 year club.
