



## Robert F. Lamkin

Robert F. "Bob" Lamkin, 76, of Evansville, passed away Friday, July 14, 2023 at Deaconess Hospital Midtown Campus.

Bob was born September 23, 1946 in Evansville to the late Leo and Elizabeth (Folz) Lamkin. He was a 1964 graduate of Mater Dei High School and served in the United States Army Reserves. 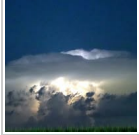
