October 18, 1948 - November 10, 2024

Rodger Dale Cox, 76, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, November 10, 2024 at the Linda E. White Hospice House surrounded by his loving family.

Rodger was born in Solitude, Indiana on October 18, 1948 to the late Charles Joseph and Marjorie (Kuester) Cox. He worked as an overhead crane operator at Alcoa for 38 years before retiring and was a veteran of the United States Army Reserves. Rodger was a member of Holy Redeemer Catholic Church; an avid reader and an Oakland and Las Vegas Raiders football fan. He enjoyed being outdoors and riding his John Deere lawnmower, but his greatest love was his family and being involved in his grandchildren's activities.

Surviving Rodger are his wife of 49 years, Jane Ann (Maurer) Cox; children, Brandon (Cathi) Cox, Barry (Ryan) Cox, Brianna (Christopher) Pratt and BriKèlle (Donnie Buedel) Cox; a brother, Charlie (Lynn) Cox and grandchildren, Guy Patrick Farber, Jakeb Stevens and Elleyanna Stevens.
