January 4, 1933 - February 27, 2018

Ronald N. Crowe, 85, of Evansville, passed away Tuesday, February 27, 2018 at his home.

Ron was born January 4, 1933 in Evansville to the late William and Mary "Mildred" (Genter) Crowe. He worked for Bucyrus Erie for 23 years and later for the Evansville Public Libraries. Ron was a veteran of the United States Navy and a member of VFW Post #1114. He was also a member of Resurrection Catholic Church, where he served as a Lector, Eucharistic Minister and sang in the choir.
