



## Ronald R. Hartmann

April 5, 1947 - January 29, 2017

Ronald R. Hartmann, age 69, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, January 29, 2017 at his home surrounded by family.

Ron was born April 5, 1947 in Evansville to the late Andrew and Eloise (Muensterman) Hartmann. He worked as a Vanderburgh County Sheriff's Deputy for 28 years before his retirement. He was a veteran of the United States Army and a life member of VFW Post #1114, the American Legion Funkhouser Post #8, Riverbend Association, Fraternal Order of Police Lodge 73, River City Eagles, Twin Towers, Westside Sportsman's Club and the Evansville Athletic Club. He was also an active member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County. Ron enjoyed making bratwurst, doing auto body work, fishing with his grandchildren and taking family vacations.
