Ronald J. Steinkamp, age 80, of Evansville, passed away on Monday, March 20, 2023 at Deaconess Hospital Midtown Campus surrounded by family.

Ron was born May 30, 1942 in Evansville to the late Joseph and Josephine (Winiger) Steinkamp. He was a lifelong Union Township farmer and served as the president of the Vanderburgh County Levee Authority for nine years.
