Rose Ann Adler, 81, of Haubstadt, passed away Wednesday, October 7, 2020 at Deaconess Hospital Gateway Campus.

Rosie was born November 12, 1938 in Wadesville, IN to the late Herman and Emma (Tenbarge) Elpers. She was an active member of St. Wendel Catholic Church and she and her husband, Gilbert, were inducted into the Brute` Society of the Diocese of Evansville for their service to the church in 2013.
