Rose Marie "Tootie" Kuhn, 84, of Evansville, passed away Friday, December 17, 2021 at her home with her sister by her side.

Rose was born February 21, 1937, during the '37 flood but not in it, to the late Adolph T. and Lorene (Ernst) Kuhn. She was a graduate of Mater Dei High School and a 1959 graduate of Marian University. Rose worked as a lab technician, mostly in hematology and chemistry, at St. Mary's Medical Center for 35 years before finishing on the lab computer in 1995. Rose was a member of St. Agnes Catholic Church and more recently, St. Boniface Catholic Church.

She is survived by her sister, Carolyn Sue Kuhn.

There will be a Mass of Christian Burial held at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, December 21, 2021 at St. Agnes Catholic Church, Rev. John Brosmer and Rev. Theodore Tempel officiating. Rose will be cremated and burial will take place in St. Joseph Cemetery.
