



Roselle Weinzapfel

December 24, 1936 - February 17, 2017

Roselle Weinzapfel died peacefully on February 17, 2017 at West River Health Campus. She was born on December 24, 1936 in Mount Vernon, Indiana.

Mrs. Weinzapfel had retired from the practice she founded, Roselle Weinzapfel, C.P.A./C.F.P., which served over 600 clients. She graduated from University of Southern Indiana in 1981 while working at Umbach & Vowels CPAs and raising her family. In 1985 Weinzapfel received a Certified Public Accountant license, followed by the Certified Financial Planner designation. Always located on Franklin Street in Evansville, her practice did general accounting, and specialized in farms and small businesses. During most years of operation, the accountants and C.P.As were all women. Throughout her career, Weinzapfel helped widows and single women understand and manage their finances.

Weinzapfel served her community through many leadership positions, including the Evansville Catholic High School Board, Daughters of Charity Board of Directors, the Conrad Baker Foundation, and as an officer of the Administrative Management Society. She served in many roles at Saint Philip Catholic Church, from organist to finance committee, where she was a member for over 60 years. Roselle was a life-long reader and a life-long bridge player. She also enjoyed antiques and travelling with her family.

Surviving Mrs. Weinzapfel are son, Stan Weinzapfel, daughter, Connie Weinzapfel, grandson Andrei Parrent, all of Saint Philip, Indiana.

Predeceasing her were her husband of 57 years, Harold, her parents Paul and Helen (Mann) Roy, her son-in-law, James Parrent Jr., and a sister, Alice, who died in infancy.

The family will receive friends on Monday, February 18 from 4:30 to 7:00pm at Pierre Funeral Home, 2601 W. Franklin St. The Rite of Christian Burial will be held at Saint Philip Catholic Church at 10:00am on Tuesday, February 19. Friends may visit with the family at 9:00 at the church before the mass.
