Ruthmae Spahn, 93, of Evansville, passed away at her home on Friday, December 3, 2021.

Ruthmae was born May 22, 1928 in Evansville to the late Edward and Helen (Titzer) Laine. She was a homemaker and a longtime member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church and more recently St. Boniface Catholic Church. She was a volunteer for the American Red Cross; a volunteer usher at The Victory Theatre, and also volunteered delivering meals for Meals on Wheels for almost 40 years. Ruthmae and her late husband Robert, hiked all 50 states; enjoyed riding their bikes and walking. She also enjoyed playing Clabber and Bridge and quilting as a member of the Sacred Heart Quilters Club.
