Sara Lee (Reid) Williams, 70 years old, of Green Cove Springs, Florida passed away on Monday, April 1, 2024 in Lakeland, Florida. She was born to the late Charles M. Reid and Carrie E. Reid on January 2, 1954 in Henderson, Kentucky. She graduated from Rex Mundi High School in Evansville, Indiana. She was married to Harold Douglas Williams for 51 years.

Sara was a stay-at-home mom during her younger years, however, once her kids were grown, she loved to travel with her husband. 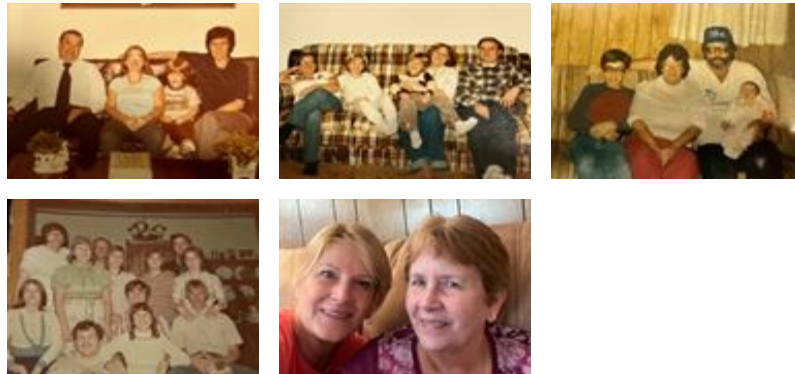

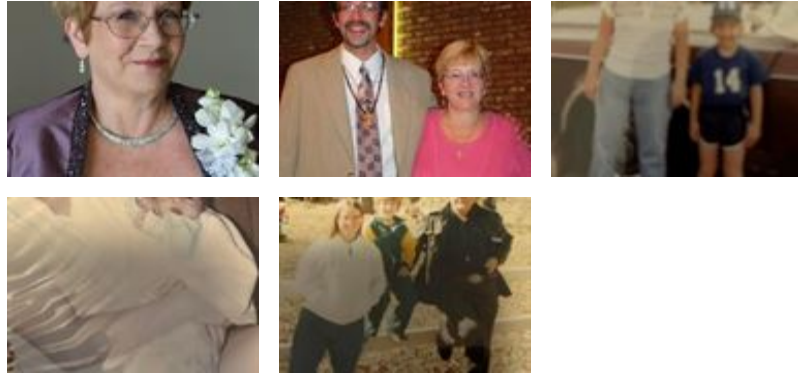
