Shirley L. Anderson, 70, of Evansville, passed away Saturday, September 16, 2017 at St. Vincent Hospital.

Shirley was born December 3, 1946 in Owensboro, KY to the late Estil and Carrie (Coleman) Anderson. He worked at Alcoa for 37 years before retiring in 2005. Shirley was a veteran of the United States Navy serving during the Vietnam War; he was a member of St. Boniface Catholic Church and a life member of both the Riverbend Association and VFW Post #1114.
