



## Sister Maria D'Anna

October 25, 1917 - April 5, 2009

Sister Maria D'Anna, O.S.C., died very peacefully on Sunday, April 5.

She was born in Homestead, PA on October 25, 1917 to Salvatore and Mary (Formosa) D'Anna and baptized Anthonina Marie.

She is preceded in death by her parents and a brother, Joseph. Surviving are her brothers, Anthony and Salvatore, Jr. "Sammy" D'Anna and a sister, Rose Bartlett.

Sister Maria was a professed Sister of the Congregation of the Third Order of St. Francis of Oldenberg, IN and officially transferred to the Order of St. Clare Monastery, Evansville, IN on September 17, 1943, made Solemn Profession in July 5, 1946. Sister Maria served in several capacities within the Poor Clare community, as formation directress, cook, seamstress, maker of priestly vestments and other Chapel adornments, artistry and music in singing.
