



Sister Mary Frances Lindenschmidt

August 12, 1918 - June 30, 2012

Sister Mary Frances Lindenschmidt of the Order of St. Clare, died Saturday, June 30, 2012 very quietly and peacefully. Her community of sisters gathered around her and prayed for her gentle passage. Sister Mary Frances was born Ruth Magdalen Frances, to Joseph and Mary (Schulte) Lindenschmidt, the eighth child of eleven. She was preceded in death by her parents and all of her siblings, Henry, Lawrence "Luke", Mary, Marguerite, Mildred, Joseph, Raymond, Charles, Louise "Dotty" and Elizabeth.

She is survived by nieces and nephews.

Sister Mary Frances entered into the Poor Clare Community following an earlier gift of her life to the Religious Community Our Lady of Victory Missionary Sisters, where she first began in March of 1937 professing Temporal Vows on August 5, 1938, followed by her Perpetual Vows on August 3, 1946. She served in 19 missions for that community and as she matured began to discern her desire for a more contemplative life of prayer.

Sister Mary Frances entered the Poor Clare cloistered, contemplative community in Evansville on August 15, 1974 for a two year transition from her previous community. She professed her First Vows as a Poor Clare with the name of Sister Mary Frances of Our Lady of the Angels on August 5, 1976 and professed her Solemn Vows as a Poor Clare on April 7, 1980. Sister Mary

Frances served this community in every capacity she was asked, with dedication and prayerful humility. She offered her sisters a quiet and strong prayer example in her living of the Poor Clare life. Mary our Lady's Angels carry her to her Heavenly Father.

Visitation will be held at the Monastery of St. Clare Chapel, 6825 Nurrenbern Road, Evansville, IN 47712 on Monday, July 2, 2012 from 5:00 until 7:00 P.M. There will be a Rosary at 7:00 P.M. CDT. Funeral services will be the Mass of the Resurrection held at the Monastery of St. Clare Chapel on Tuesday, July 3, 2012 at 10:00 A.M., CDT. Graveside services will follow in St. Joseph Catholic Cemetery.
