Stafford Rex Sawyer, age 82, of Wadesville, passed away Saturday, October 08, 2011 at Deaconess Hospital.

Mr. Sawyer was a farmer and insurance salesman for Mutual Insurance of Southern Indiana before retiring in 2003. Rex was a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church in Poseyville. He was a veteran of the United States Marine Corps, charter member of the Wadesville Fire Department, had served as a Special Deputy on the Posey County Sheriff Department for 30 years and on the Posey County Sheriff Department Merit Board for 20 years. He also served as a Director of the Posey County Co-op and on the Board of Directors of Mutual Insurance of Southern Indiana.

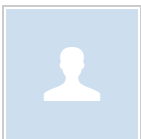
