Stanley Dale "Stan" Lovell, age 67, passed away Saturday, May 29, 2021 at his home.

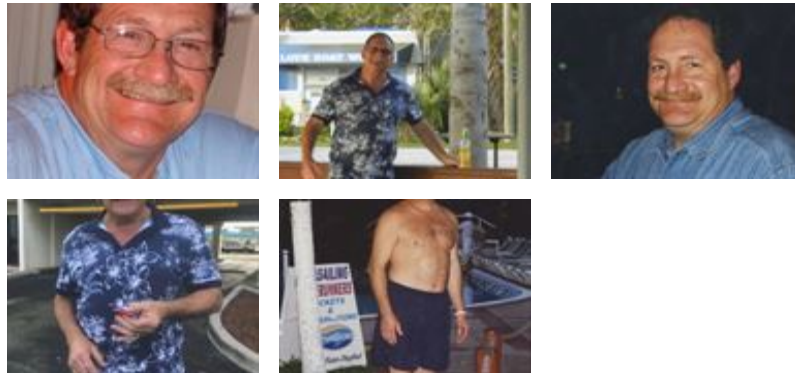
