Stephen A. Dausmann, 66, of Mt. Vernon, IN, passed away on Saturday, September 30, 2017 at his home surrounded by his family.

Steve was born March 3, 1951 in Evansville to the late Arnold and Doris (Weiss) Dausmann. He was a graduate of Mt. Vernon Senior High School and Indiana University where he was a member of Theta Chi fraternity. Steve was president of Dausmann Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep until 2007 and also served as a past president of the Dodge Dealer Advertising Association and was a member of the Dodge Dealer Council. Steve also served his community as a past president of the Mt. Vernon Chamber of Commerce, past board member of the Old National Community Bank Board and as a member of the Hadi Shrine Temple and Beulah Lodge #578. He was a member of St. Philip Catholic Church, Mt. Vernon, IN and St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church, The Villages, FL. Steve enjoyed spending weekends boating on the Ohio River and Barkley Lake, following IU basketball, bowling in the Shriner's League and was a MOPAR enthusiast.

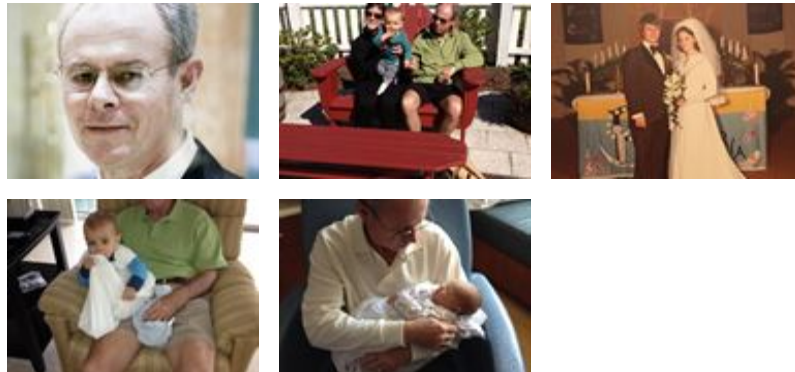
