Steven Douglas Moore, age 67, of Evansville, passed away Tuesday, June 11, 2013 at Deaconess Hospital.

Steve was born March 31, 1946 in Evansville to Malcolm and Ruth (Reising) Moore. He graduated from Mater Dei High School, received a Bachelor's degree from Indiana State University and his Masters of Business Administration from the University of Evansville. Steve proudly served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War. On July 8, 2000, he married the former, Jan Bradley. Steve treasured his wife, family and lifelong friendships. He will be remembered by all as a devoted husband, son, father and friend.
