



## Sylvester Frank Goedde

August 31, 1920 - September 24, 2012

Sylvester Frank Goedde, age 92, of Evansville, passed away Monday, September 24, 2012 at Deaconess Hospital Main Campus.

Mr. Goedde was a founding member of Resurrection Catholic Church and a sheet metal worker with Midwest Roofing and Sheet Metal and Local #20 for 35 years. He was a veteran of WWII serving in the United States Army.
