Tamara Marie (Deal) Lingafelter, age 54, of Wadesville, went home to be with the Lord Friday, April 10th, 2020 at her residence. We are all devastated by this sudden and unexpected loss of our wife, mother, daughter, sister, aunt, nana, and friend. All of our lives have been touched by her love.

She was a dedicated mother first and foremost. She treasured her children and embraced every moment with them. She especially loved her role as Nana. She enjoyed her family, being outside, and spending time at Barkley Lake with her Schroeder family.

Tammy was a 1983 graduate of North Posey High School and a 1987 graduate of the University of Southern Indiana, where she graduated with a Computer Science BS Degree. She began her career with American General in 1987, during her 32-year career at OneMain Financial, Tammy contributed to the development of various financial applications, but more importantly built relationships which positively impacted many people's lives. She was a life-long member of Zion Lippe United Church of Christ.
