



## Terrie Dawn Becher

May 20, 1955 - October 18, 2022

Terrie Dawn Phillips Becher, 67, of Evansville, passed away on Tuesday, October 18, 2022 at Deaconess Hospital Midtown Campus surrounded by her family.

Terrie was born May 20, 1955 in Evansville. She was the daughter of William Keith Sr. and Beverly Joyce (Brink) Phillips. She married John Alan Becher on December 30, 1978. They were blessed with five beautiful children and seven grandchildren.

Terrie worked as a dental assistant for Dr. James R. Bishop for three years on Evansville's west side.
