



## Terry Muensterman

January 17, 1952 - April 9, 2021

Teresa Ann “Terry” Muensterman, 69, of Evansville, passed away at her home on Friday, April 9, 2021.

Terry was born January 17, 1952 in Evansville to the late Kenneth J. “Mac” and Elizabeth Ann “Betty” (Bristow) McAtee. She was a 1970 graduate of Mater Dei High School and married her high school sweetheart, Carl James Muensterman. They were married for 48 years. She was proud that she was the first graduate of Mater Dei High School to have both of her parents as Mater Dei alumni. While at Mater Dei, Terry was a member of the choir and the Pom Pom Squad marching with the band. Following graduation, she worked for Indiana Bell. Her enjoyment of ceramics, sewing and many other crafts lead her to take a position with the Evansville Public Library system, where she directed the children’s programs. She was a beloved Brownie Troop leader to many girls on the west side and made hand stamped greeting cards for local nursing homes. As her children grew, she worked with the office at Burdette Park and retired from the University of Southern Indiana in 1999 when she became a full-time grandma. She would always be found sitting on the sidelines of the ball fields or in the audience of an auditorium cheering for her grandchildren through their activities. She had an eye for all things pretty and was a passionate gift giver.
