Theodore E. Forbes, 71, of Evansville passed away Monday, May 05, 2008 at his home.

Mr. Forbes had served as a minister for over 40 years in the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) and Methodist denominations. He was an Elder in the South Indiana Conference and attended Epworth United Methodist Church. He was a past president of the Westside Kiwanis Club, a frequent donor to the American Red Cross, a C.A.S.A. advocate and past member of Friendship Ministries.
