

Theodore Wilbert Niemeier Sr.

February 7, 1934 - July 9, 2023

Theodore Wilbert “Ted” Niemeier, Sr., 89, of Evansville, passed away peacefully on Sunday, July 9, 2023 surrounded by family.

Ted was born February 7, 1934 in Evansville to the late Wilbert “Whip” and Catherine “Kate” (Mueller) Niemeier. He was a 1950 graduate of FJ Reitz High School where he played football and was a member of the All-City football team. Ted also attended Evansville College from 1951-1955 where he was an All-Conference football player. He worked as a teacher with the EVSC at Harwood School and Central High School and was an assistant football, baseball and track coach while at Central. Ted also served on the Evansville Parks Board and was a member of the ETA, ISTA and NEA.

Surviving Ted are three sons, Ted, Jr. (Kathy), Jeff (Linda), Mark (Debbie) and daughter Ann Claspell; a sister-in-law, Ruby Niemeier; grandchildren, Angela (Greg) Brasen, Ben (France), Chris (Jessica), Amy (Tom) Wright, Jodi (Tony) Ayslworth, Megan (Beth) Coleman, Zach, Ty (Samantha), Jill and Grant Claspell; twelve great grandchildren and several great great grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, Ted was preceded in death by his wife of 64 years, Marian (Snyder) Niemeier in 2019 and by a brother, Jim Niemeier.

There will be a Mass of Christian Burial held at 10:00 AM on Friday, July 14,

2023 at St. Boniface Catholic Church, Rev. Lowell Will officiating. Burial will follow in St. Joseph Cemetery.

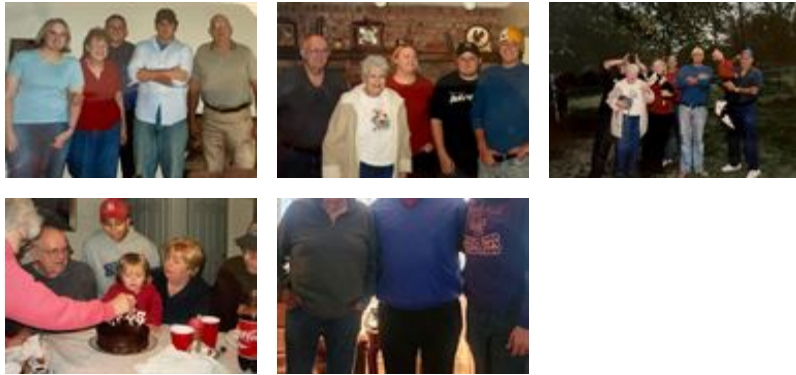

Rest in peace Mr. Niemeier.

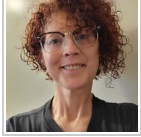

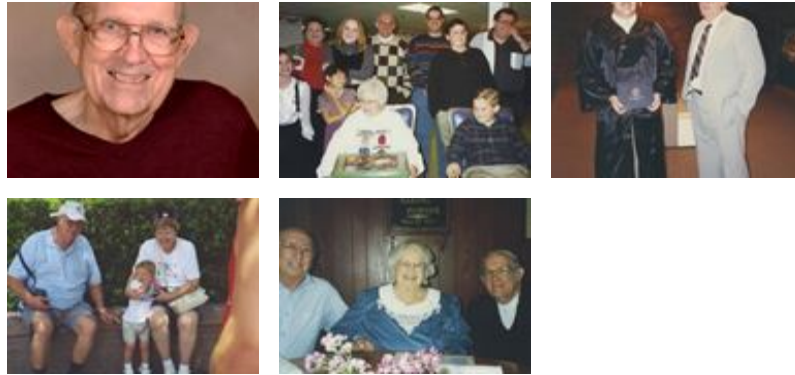

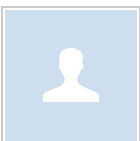
