Theresa Cecile (Kohut) Lintzenich, 68, of Indianapolis, passed away at the Linda E. White Hospice House in Evansville on Friday, June 16, 2023.

Theresa was born December 30, 1954 in Evansville to the late Andrew J. and Marie F. (Deom) Kohut. She later moved to Indianapolis, where she was a registered nurse and had worked in the mother baby unit of Methodist Hospital, as well as for Tendercare Home Health Services. Over the years, she also took time off from nursing to work part time at Bishop Chatard High School and Great Harvest Bread Company.

Theresa was an active member of Christ the King Catholic Church in Indianapolis, where she volunteered her time for a variety of events, including the annual Summer Social. She was also an avid fan of college sports and didn't miss a Butler Basketball game.
