Thomas A. Diehl, 75, of Evansville, passed away on Sunday, January 28, 2024 at St. Vincent Hospital.

Tom was born August 16, 1948 in Evansville to the late Albert A. and Mary Louise (Hooper) Diehl. He was a 1966 graduate of Rex Mundi High School. Tom worked as a maintenance supervisor at Bootz Manufacturing for many years before retiring and owned and operated The Corner Bar. He was a veteran of the United States Air Force serving during the Vietnam War. Tom loved sports, playing golf and participating in spot shoots, but more than anything loved spending time with this family and two granddaughters.

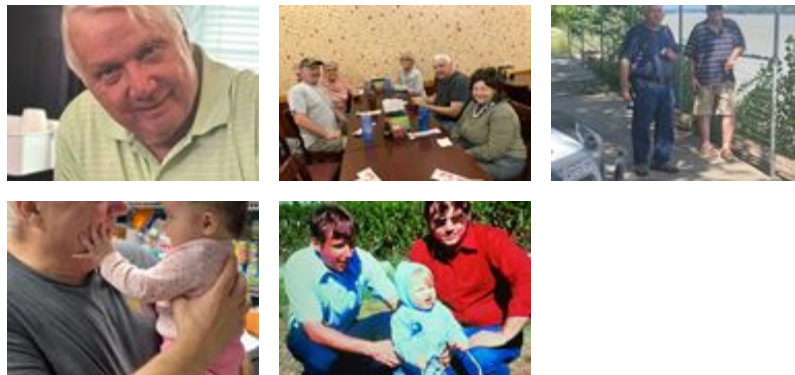
