



Thomas Allen Kirsch

January 31, 1950 - July 17, 2021

Thomas Allen Kirsch, age 71, of Evansville, passed away at his home surrounded by his family on Saturday, July 17, 2021.

Tom was born January 31, 1950 in Evansville to the late Charles Jacob and Loyola Mary (Wolf) Kirsch. He and his wife, Dolores, raised nine children together and they had a great love for the church. He was a faithful member of St. Philip Catholic Church, where he was inducted into the Simon Brute` Society for his service to the church. Tom was ordained a Deacon of the Diocese of Evansville in 2013; he was a member of the Knights of Columbus; an avid supporter of Posey County Right to Life and the Little Sisters of the Poor. Tom was a member of Plumbers and Steamfitters Local 136 and served many elderly people through his trade, manual labor, his friendship and genuine love.

In addition to his parents, Tom was preceded in death by an infant son, Timothy Kirsch; by a sister, Elizabeth Tucker and brother, Michael Kirsch.

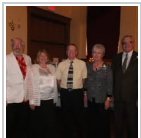

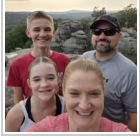
