



## Thomas Frederick Wannemuehler

February 28, 1972 - April 10, 2022

Thomas F. Wannemuehler, 50, of rural Evansville, passed away unexpectedly Sunday, April 10, 2022 at his home.

Tom was born February 28, 1972 to the late Joseph and Florence (Schenk) Wannemuehler. He worked as the warehouse manager for Heritage Petroleum and was a member of St. Philip Catholic Church, the St. Philip Conservation Club and the Knights of Columbus.
