Toni Marie (Seibert) Flamion of Evansville, Indiana took a final peaceful breath on June 21, 2024 after a long battle with dementia.

Toni was the first child born to James and Angelina (Datillo) Seibert on December 13, 1940 in Evansville. She attended St. Benedict Grade School, and was a proud graduate of Mater Dei High School in 1958. After high school, Toni worked as a flight attendant and worked for Eastern Airlines. She also worked as the executive secretary at Old Ben Coal company while her children were young, and later enjoyed a career as a realtor for various agencies in the Evansville and Newburgh area.
