Trevor A. Head, 41, of Evansville, passed from this life unexpectedly on Sunday, October 14, 2007. Trevor was the beloved husband to Debra (Bradley) Head and devoted father to Ethan, age 13, Mason, age 11, and Christian, age 3. He was the loving son of Jennie (Buckman) and Michael A. Head of Evansville and a dedicated brother to Tracey Gannon, Marcey Vanpell and Lorrie Weiss.

As husband and father, Trevor's number one priority was always family. He participated in many activities with the boys, including Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts and sports. Trevor, Debbie and their sons enjoyed traveling and he loved to introduce the boys to new experiences on their vacations. The family enjoyed time outdoors, camping, fishing and hiking. While they visited many states and national parks, and took a trip to England, the most important thing to Trevor was always that the family was together. Trevor was also passionate about cooking (and eating!).

Trevor was a 1984 graduate of Mater Dei High School. He graduated from Purdue University in 1988 with a B.S. degree in Financial Management. In 1990, Trevor married his high school sweetheart, Debra. He was Regional Sales Manager for Seco Tools.

As a son, Trevor was devoted and loving, bringing joy and much happiness to

his parents. As a brother, Trevor thoroughly enjoyed spending time with his three sisters, and was always helping out when needed. He sought out his sisters for their friendship, which grew even stronger over the years. As a friend, Trevor was loyal and generous, actively engaged in his community via his membership at Resurrection Catholic Church and the German Township Booster Club where he volunteered his time for many fund-raising activities.

In addition to his immediate family, Trevor is survived by his mother-in-law and father-in-law, Mary Jane (Gries) and Ernest Bradley and nieces and nephews.

Funeral services for Trevor will begin at 10:30 A.M. Thursday at Resurrection Catholic Church, Rev. Philip Kreilein officiating. Burial will follow in St. Joseph Catholic Cemetery.

Friends may visit with the family from 2:00 until 8:00 P.M. Wednesday, October 17, 2007 at Pierre Funeral Home and from 9:30 A.M. until service time Thursday at Resurrection Catholic Church.
