Vernie Robert “Bob” Bender, II, age 76, of Evansville, passed away at his home on Monday, December 26, 2022 with his wife and the love of his life for 56 years, Vicki, by his side and surrounded by family.

Bob was born July 22, 1946 in Evansville to the late Vernie and Loretta (Strueh) Bender. He worked for Bristol Myers as a sterile drug compounder before retiring. 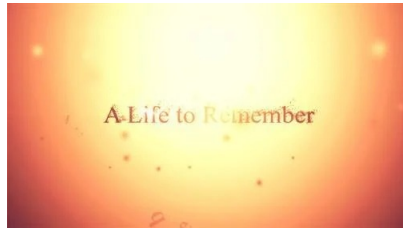
