Victor G. Schenk, age 90, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, September 6, 2012 at the Good Samaritan Home.

Mr. Schenk was a farmer and had worked for Arkla, Servel and Deaconess Hospital before his retirement in 1987. He was a veteran of the United States Navy, serving during WWII and was a member of VFW Post #1114. Victor was a past member of Local #808, and a member of the Owls, Eagles, Riverbend Association and the St. Philip Conservation Club.

Surviving are his wife of 64 years, Helen (Bayer) Schenk; a daughter, Jeanne Schenk and son, Harold (Claudia) Schenk, both of Evansville.
