Virginia V. (Paul) Helmer, 88, of Evansville, passed away Wednesday, February 7, 2018 at the Good Samaritan Home.

Virginia was born December 18, 1929 in Poseyville, IN to the late Joseph and Rosella (Lamey) Paul. Virginia was a member of St. Wendel Catholic Church, where she was inducted into the Brute Society of the Diocese of Evansville. She was a member of the VFW Ladies Auxiliary and served as the state president in 1984-1985. She was an avid quilter and a recipient of the Sagamore of the Wabash award.
