Virginia “Genna” Schoolfield, 93, of Evansville, passed away Saturday, October 25, 2025, at Deaconess Hospital Midtown Campus.

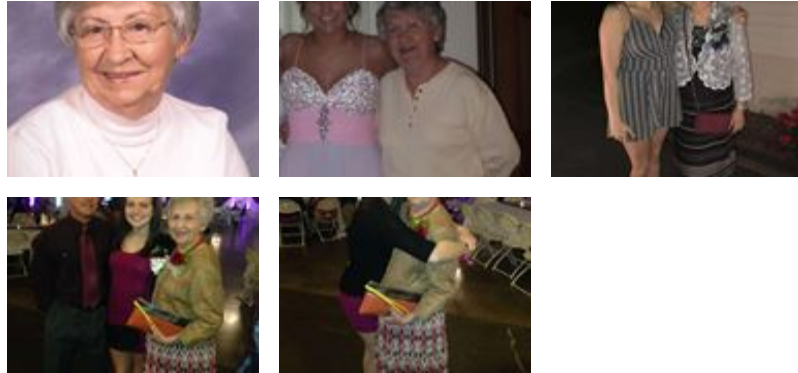
