Willard A. Unfried, age 82, of Evansville, passed away Friday, September 28, 2012 at his home.

Mr. Unfried was a 57 year member of Sheet Metal Workers Local #20. He was a member of Resurrection Catholic Church and a veteran of the United States Air Force serving in the Korean War. Willard enjoyed woodworking, was a longtime Democrat Precinct Committeeman in German Township and a member of the German Township Fire Department.
