William E. "Bill" Deeg, 88, of rural Evansville, passed away on Saturday, January 24, 2026, at the Evansville Protestant Home.

Bill was born on August 18, 1937, in Evansville to the late Elmer O. and Clara (Stratman) Deeg. He worked as a pharmacist at his family's pharmacy, Deeg's Pharmacy, and also Great Scot Pharmacy and Walmart Pharmacy before retiring. 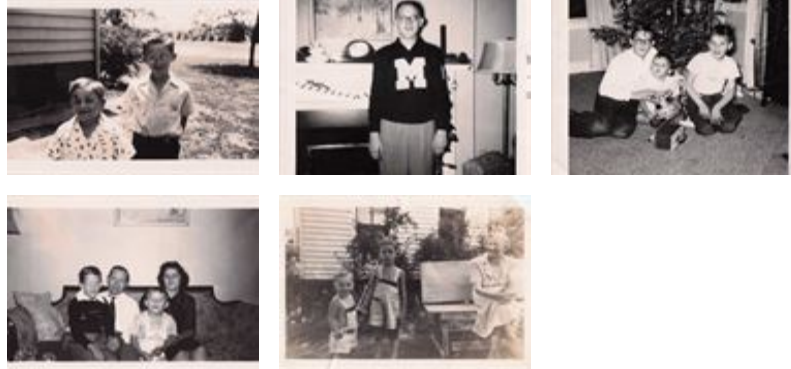

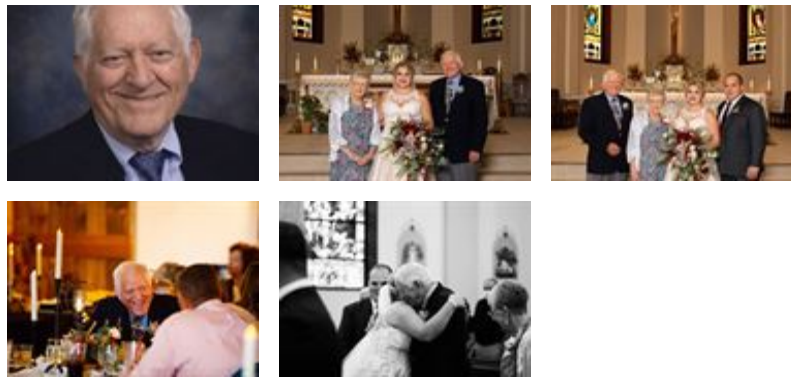
