William Joe Goebel, 84, of Evansville, passed away Tuesday, December 15, 2020 at his home surrounded by family.

Bill was born July 11, 1936 in Evansville to the late Victor A. and Cecelia M. (Wirthwein) Goebel. He retired from Whirlpool Corporation after over 40 years of service; was a member of Corpus Christi Catholic Church and past president of the Corpus Christi Men's Club. Bill was also a member of the Riverbend Association and the Knights of St. John. Bill was an avid sports fan and enjoyed attending as many of his grandchildren's sporting events as he could. He never met a stranger and he and his friends from high school played poker once a month for the last 50 years. 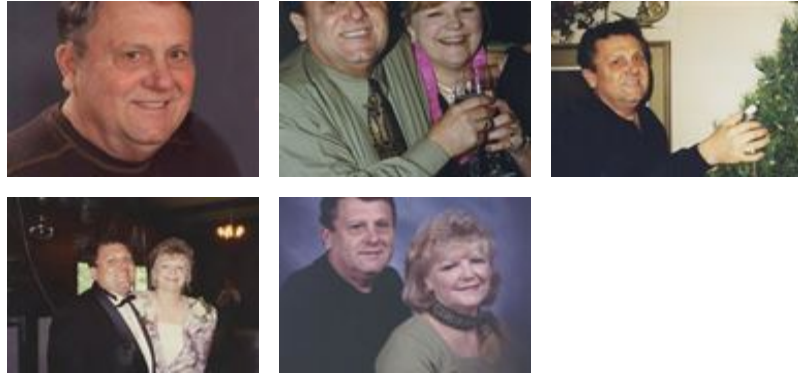
