William "Earl" Williams, 92, of Evansville, passed away Monday, June 5, 2017 at Deaconess Hospital.

Earl was born May 22, 1925 in Madisonville, KY to the late William Gordon and Lola (Fraser) Williams. He worked at Union Federal Savings Bank for 36 years, where he served as a senior vice president and a member of the Board of Directors. He was a veteran of the United States Army serving in Europe during World War II.
