William W. "Bill" Williams, 84, of Haubstadt, passed away at 2:15 A.M. on Monday, April 23, 2018 at River Oaks in Princeton.

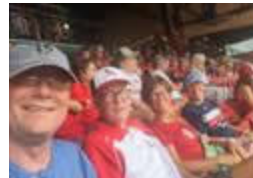
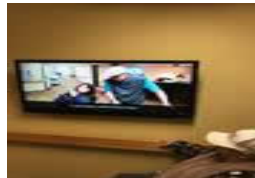
