Deacon William Leo Heberling, 50, of Evansville died Saturday, June 4.

Bill was born April 11, 1961, in Heidelberg, Germany, the son of Ron Heberling and Renata Kollmar. He grew up in Tower City, Pennsylvania, where he was raised by his grandparents, Leo and Doris Heberling.

Bill move to Evansville in the mid 1980's and worked in the health care profession, first at Warrick Hospital and then later at St. Mary's in Evansville. Bill graduated from the University of Southern Indiana with majors in psychology and sociology and a minor in criminal justice. He completed his studies for the diaconate through St. Meinrad School of Theology. He was pursuing a masters degree when he became ill.

Bill was ordained a deacon for the Catholic Diocese of Evansville July 9, 2005. He served particularly the westside communities of St. Agnes, Sacred Heart and St. Boniface. He also assisted with hospital ministry at St. Mary's and in jail ministry at various locations. He participated in the Churches Embracing Offenders program and regularly conducted worship services at the State Hospital.

Bill was preceded in death by his parents and his grandfather, Leo Heberling. He is survived by his grandmother, Doris, by his siblings, John, Carol and

Brenda and by his close friends, Tom Harness, Nancy Hawkins and Sr. Sylvia Gehlhausen, O.S.B.

A funeral Mass will be conducted at 10:00am Tuesday at St. Agnes Church with Bishop-emeritus Gerald Gettelfinger presiding with the priests and deacons of the diocese. There will be a private internment at St. Joseph Cemetery.
